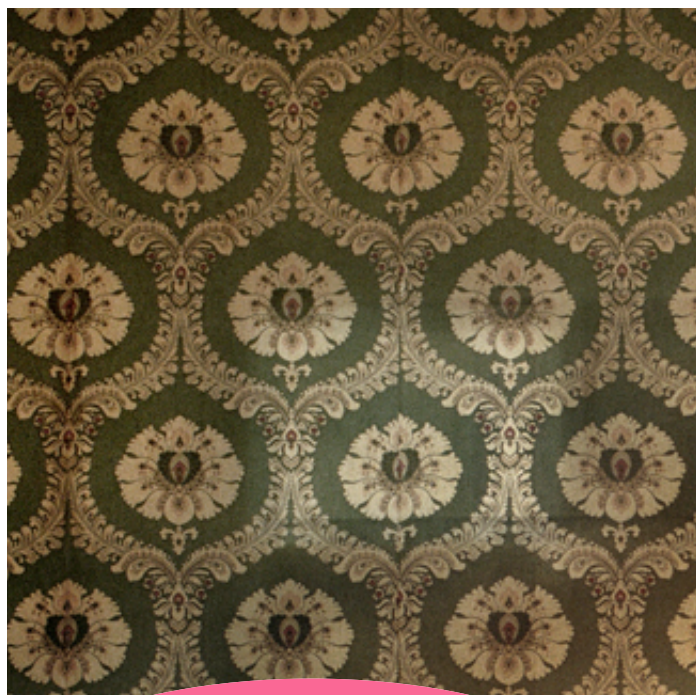

In 1960, Rome hosted the 17th edition of the Olympic Games of the modern era.
